Any such decision will be binding upon all parties. The RVMS Executive Director and the FM Manager are responsible for enforcing the Market Policy.*

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### **Organizations:**

This table would be a space for non-profit and other community based groups who are not making a profit, but may not necessarily possess 501c3 status. Roslindale nonprofits and organizations would receive priority. Organizations must be appropriate to within the market environment. No organization at this table will be politically affiliated group, as per RVMS policy.

### **Content:**

This table will be for information and engagement purposes only! Organizations may hand out information or have an activity, but are not permitted to sell items or services at their booth. Handouts, information sheets, sign up sheets etc. are allowed and encouraged. If an organization desires to sell items they must apply.

### **Market Day:**

Organizations may begin set up as early as 7:30 am, but must be completely set up by 8:45 am for the 9:00 am opening. Organizations must stay through the entirety of the market from 9am to 1:30pm. Unloading and loading of vehicles must take place at the park's perimeter. All vehicles must be moved by 8:30 am. To prevent competition with local businesses, organizations are encouraged to park their vehicles in the **MBTA lower parking lot behind Adams Park on South Street**. If you are not parked here you are at risk of being towed (it has happened!).

RVMS can provide a table upon request, but unfortunately cannot provide a tent. The location of the Community Stall will be set at the start of the season and all attempts will be made for it to remain the same location throughout the season.

### **Scheduling:**

RVMS and/or the farmers market committee will accept organizations based on relevance to market, location (priority to Roslindale organizations), diversity of organizations, timing, RVMS mission and priorities, and community appeal. Applications open February 16th and close March 31st.
